## Terms & Conditions

1. The name of the club will be "Pett Village Hall - 500 Club"
2. Membership is set at 500 members. Members may apply for more than one number if they so wish. Members will be allocated a permanent number in the order in which they apply. This number shall remain the member's provided their subscription is up to date.
3. A subscription of £12.00 per year per number is payable annually 12 months in advance by cheque. Annually or monthly by Bank Standing Order.
4. Members will be invited to renew their membership on the anniversary of their joining month giving details of the name and number(s) via Email (Bcc) as available. For data protection, details are not supplied to any Third Party.
5. The object of the 500 Club is to raise funds for Pett Village Hall.
6. There will be a one monthly prize draw using a maximum of 500 numbers.
7. 50% of the money collected for that month will go towards the funding of Pett Village Hall.
8. Of the remaining 50%, there will be three prizes divided by 60% for first ,25% for second and 15% for third.
9. For example: Prize money collected: £500. £250 will go towards the Pett Village Hall funds of the remaining £250 First Prize would be £150, second prize would be £62.50 and third would be £37.50
10. If a number drawn is not allocated, the next active number will be a winner.
11. The monthly draw will take place after the end of each month at a public event, e.g. Monthly Coffee Morning by a member of the Management Committee or their representative, in the presence of at least two independent witnesses. The winners will be notified and paid within the next week or as soon as reasonably possible. The names of the winners will be published.
12. The 500 Club shall be run by the Management Committee of Pett Village Hall and their decision will be binding on all parties in case of any dispute. The Management Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 500 Club members as is necessary.
13. The books will be fully audited at the end of each twelve months.
14. An on-going list of winning numbers will be displayed in the Pett Parish News, on Pett on the Net, [www.pettnet.org.uk](http://www.pettnet.org.uk) , Pett Village Hall notice board and at local businesses.
15. All participants must be 16 years old or over..
16. If it is found that the Standing Order is no longer current or valid it will be assumed the person wishes to cease their membership of the Pett Village Hall – 500 Club.
